

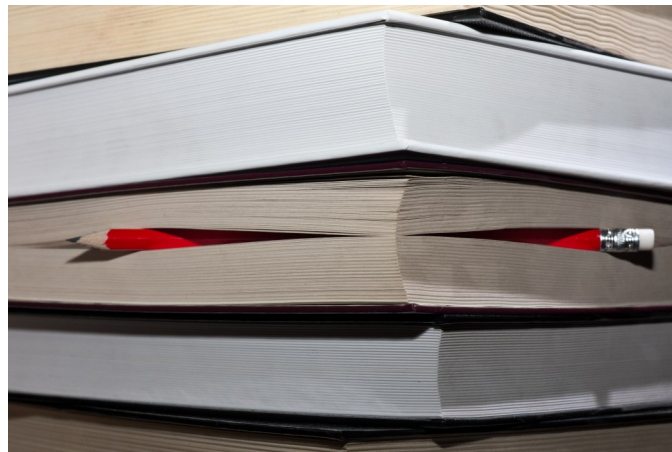
Getting it Right: Style and Referencing in a History Essay
